Bible - We will be learning again about how the Israelites sinned by complaining against Moses. Though, they were really complaining about the way in which God was treating them. Even Miriam and Aaron were guilty of this sin. Before we start thinking, "How terrible the Israelites were" we need to remember that we frequently complain against our parents, teacher, and God. We will learn the character trait of forgiveness and how God expects us to forgive those who have treated us wrongly, rather than get even.

Math - We are embarking on our final math unit, division concepts. We will be learning concepts such as making equal groups and how we can use repeated subtraction to divide. We will be working on our subtraction speed drills for these final two weeks!

Reading - We will be reading two stories, first is called *The Song of Happy People*. In the story, a pessimistic stranger visits a village and discourages the people from completing their work. The happy singing in the village also stops. A wise man named Mr. McDoogie then reminds the people to do what they must to finish the work, and once again the people in the village happily sing and work. The second story is called *When Singing Came Again*. A tragedy abruptly ends the singing in Vanessa's island home. Later, Vanessa and her mother help a young boy who plays a harmonica, his little sister, and their sick mother. Not long afterward, singing comes again to Vanessa's home.

English - We are continuing to review important writing concepts. We will spend time on capitalization and punctuation. We will also work on the importance of our word choices to make our creative writing more exciting. I'm really enjoying all the creativity your children are sharing! ☺
