## Morning Drop-Off Improves

As we have started the school year, everyone has been doing a great job learning, including the adults! After observing the morning drop-off for a few days, there are a few tips that will help all the students get to class on time. Please take a look. We know you'll do your best!



1. Any vehicle with at least **one** student in kindergarten through 2nd grade, needs to use the lane closest to the school when dropping off the students in that vehicle.
2. **ALWAYS** wait for a volunteer to assist your child or children out of the car. Please do not let children out of the car before the designated drop-off area with volunteers present. This is vital for the safety of our children and to keep the line running smoothly.
3. Be sure children are prepared to step out of the vehicle by the time they reach the volunteers:
  - a. backpacks and lunch boxes ready,
  - b. masks ready
  - c. hugs and kisses and goodbyes before getting to the door, or very quickly
  - d. be ready to unbuckle and exit the vehicle as soon as the car stops moving
  - e. encourage children to walk quickly into the building
4. Vehicles with the youngest student in the vehicle in 3rd grade and up, **please** use the outside lane
5. If your student is tardy (after 8:30 a.m.), please park your car, then walk him or her into the building to sign them in.

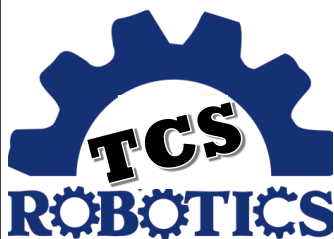

### **Middle School History Teacher**

We are seeking a full-time, enterprising, middle school history teacher for the 2021-2022 school year. Qualified candidates will have at least a bachelor's degree and current teacher certification.
