### See You At the Pole

During the See You At the Pole chapel, Mr. Bekermier talked about prayer. He talked to us about the different ways that God answers our prayers. Even though God answers our prayers in different ways, all of them are the right answer. If God's answer to your prayer is no, there is a reason He said no. No matter how God answers our prayers, we should always be thankful even if He didn't answer our prayers the way we wanted Him to. Mr. Bekermier also told us about how God doesn't always solve our problems, but He will give us hope. He also told us that if you ask God for wisdom, He will give it to you. Mr. Bekermier told us that prayer shouldn't just be requests and that you should also that God for what He has done for you. He told us that you should ask for forgiveness during prayer and that sometimes you have to listen during prayer instead of talking. Some of the verses we talked about were: Jeremiah 33:3, James 4:10, Hebrews 13:5, James 1:5, and Psalm 56:4. Heartsong led us in the song *Good, Good, Father*, and Mrs. Woodford and Mrs. Tanka led us in *Amazing Grace*. Everyone also separated by class and prayed, and Mr. V prayed for all of us around the flag pole.

### **Spanish Teacher**

We are seeking a part-time Spanish teacher for the 2021-2022 school year. Qualified candidates should have at least a bachelor's degree and experience in speaking and teaching Spanish. 


