Chapel Speaker: Pastor Shad Peyton

In chapel, we have been talking about trust, and the verse for the theme is Proverbs 3:5-6. Wednesday, we focused on Proverbs 3:5, "lean not on your own understanding." The point from Proverbs 3:5 is that sometimes you might not know what to do when you come to problems in life. It's okay to lean on people to help you, but sometimes that someone might not know what to do. "Lean not on your own understanding" means that you should be able to lean or trust someone else to do something. When that person doesn't know what to do, you feel like you have a blindfold on and you can't see where you're going. So when you're in that tight spot, do what Proverbs 3:5 says and lean on Christ and he will guide you. We have the power to pray. Sometimes we might not think that God's listening or is ignoring us when we pray, but he always listens to us and might not answer the way you think he might answer. So, when you feel like you're blindfolded, always go back to Proverbs 3:5-6 and remember to lean on God and he will make your paths straight.
