April 10-11, 33 eighth graders, Mrs. Balek, Miss Bekermeier, and 17 parents headed to Kentucky to visit and explore the Creation Museum and Ark Encounter. This trip built upon what these students have learned about creation and the flood in Bible and science class.

The students had some impactful conversations while walking through the Creation Museum and Ark Encounter, as they made connections to what they learned in class. They were impressed by the detail in the museums and all of the information both had to offer. The class loved exploring different exhibits and insightful experiences throughout such as the seven Cs in God's eternal plan (Creation, Corruption, Catastrophe, Confusion, Christ, Cross, Consummation); a 4D movie on the seven days of creation; an exhibit focused on precious babies and abortion called "Fearfully and Wonderfully Made;" an in-depth display at the ark of what it looked like and what was inside of it; a live message from Dr. Jennifer Hall Rivera, and more.

On top of all the learning, everyone shared in laughter and created many memories from walking through the petting zoo, the lunch and dinner stops, time at the pool, conversations on the road trip, and funny moments that happened. The group had a blast bonding as a class and were thankful for such a memorable and great trip. Here are some quotes from our eighth graders about the trip:

"Through this trip, I learned that God loves us so much and he gave us dominion over the earth and all animals and plants. God made his creation perfect. Our sin ruined it, but Jesus washed all sin away by dying on the cross so that we could have the gift of salvation." -Haven F.



BLESS A TCS FAMILY AND RECEIVE A BLESSING AT TAX TIME

As of today, 37 students have been approved to receive scholarships to attend Trinity Christian School through the Illinois Invest in Kids Act. Five students have been funded thus far and 32 remain on the waiting list for the 2023-2024 school year.

> This program is funded by individual donors contributing to Empower Illinois. Empower Illinois facilitates the process of scholarship funds reaching qualified families. The donation process is accomplished by donors contributing through Empower Illinois and designating the scholarship be awarded to qualified students attending Trinity Christian School in Region 3.

> By donating to this scholarship program, you will receive a tax credit in the amount of 75% of your donation. This is not a tax deduction, it is a tax credit, so it directly reduces your Illinois

State tax bill. For example, if your Illinois State Tax Bill is \$1,000 and you make a \$1,000 donation to Empower Illinois directing your contribution to Trinity Christian School in Region 3, you will receive a \$750 tax credit. This will reduce the tax bill you owe to the state of Illinois to \$250.









