IMPORTANT CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT REMINDERS

Remember that current K-8 families who are ready to bring a new student to TCS may begin an application for the student by simply logging into your FACTS Family Portal. This includes current K-8 families who would like to enroll a student in kindergarten.

Once logged in, click **Apply/Enroll**, then **Application**. Please select the application titled **Current K-8 Family, New Student Application 2026-2027** and follow all of the steps.

Also, please keep in mind that the deadline to opt your student out for the coming school year is **Feb. 27, 2026**. If you choose to educate your child elsewhere for the 2026-2027 school year, please contact Mrs. Ellen Rasmussen, Registrar, at 815-577-9310, ext. 300 or erasmussen@trinitychristian.info.

Finally, in April, all reenrolled families will receive an email inviting them to update important information such as emergency contacts and medical information. Families will have **two weeks** to complete this information.



Families currently enrolled at Trinity Christian School can earn a one-time \$250 tuition credit for each new family they refer that enrolls in kindergarten through eighth grade.



PLEASE KEEP SICK CHILDREN AT HOME

The United States is currently in the midst of flu season. With that said, here are some important guidelines pertaining to attendance and illness.

Students must be fever-free, without the aid of medication, for 24 hours before returning to school. Similarly, students who have vomited or had diarrhea MUST be symptom-free for 24 hours, without the aid of medication, before returning to school.

Students involved in activities must be in attendance at school for at least half of the day (arrive before 11:30 a.m. or remain at school until 11:30 a.m. in order to participate in any extracurricular competitions, performances, or activities over the weekend.


