## **CONGRATULATIONS TCS ROBOTICS TEAM!**

A Trinity Christian School's robotics team was recently recognized for their efforts at the FIRST LEGO League Challenge Qualifying Tournament held Saturday, Dec. 4, 2021, at The University of Illinois in Urbana-Champaign, IL.

Of the six TCS teams that participated, Team M & M received the "Rising All-Star Award," which "celebrates a team that the judges notice and expect great things from in the future," according to competition materials. Team members included third grade students Nikolai D., Mya M., Joseph M., Christian P., Rafey S., and Tanner V. Fourth



grade team members were Aidan C., Aria M., and Carly P. This group was coached by Mrs. Amy McKnight, a Trinity parent.

The robotics program is a new extracurricular activity at Trinity this year. It was started and coached by two Trinity teachers, Mrs. Christine McBride and Ms. Terese Osacky. Parent coaches were also a vital part of developing the teams.

Fifty-two students in third through eighth grade participated in Trinity's program, once a week, August through December. Everything they learned prepared them for the December competition against eight other teams at the tournament.

Students engaged in research, problem-solving, coding and engineering – to build and program a LEGO robot that could navigate the missions of a robot game table. As part of the challenge, teams also participated in a research project to identify and solve a relevant real-world problem and presented their findings and solution to a judging panel.

"We are so very proud of all of them," stated Coach McBride. "In the beginning of the year many of them had no idea what a robotics team was or what it meant to be on a robotics team. They have accomplished so much."



According to its website, "FIRST LEGO League introduces science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) to children ages 4-16 through fun, exciting hands-on learning. Participants gain real-world problem solving experience through a guided, global robotics program, helping today's students and teachers build a better future together."
