#### TCS CHAPEL UPDATE

Our chapel theme for this school year is entitled "Run to the Father." We are focusing on Psalm 55:22 where it says, "Cast your cares on the Lord and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous be shaken." This year, we will look at different ways we can run to the Father or what we can run to him for. Last week, we looked at who the Father is and why we should run to him. In the coming weeks, we will look at the prodigal son, running to the Father in times of trouble, running to Jesus for salvation, and running to Christ above all else. Our hope and prayer this year is that our students would RUN TO THE FATHER. We desire for them to run to him FIRST – before going to anything else or anyone else. We want them to run TO him for all of their needs and run WITH him throughout their whole lives. Throughout these chapels, we pray that our students will understand what it means to walk with Jesus daily and to live a life as a true follower and disciple of Jesus.

In addition, this year we will have monthly split chapels that are geared to our specific students' needs. Our split chapels will occur about once a month – Sept. 17, Oct. 15, Dec. 10, Jan. 21, March 11, and April 22. On these dates kindergarten through fifth grade will still have chapel at 8:40 a.m., and sixth through eighth grade will have chapel at 9:30 a.m. Elementary students will focus on kindness, comparison, truth, self-control, self-worth, and joy; while our middle school students will go deeper with who God is and the qualities of Christ, why we should desire a relationship with Jesus, distractions of technology, relationships, and Christian community. We look forward to seeing how our students grow deeper in their relationship

with Jesus through these chapels.
