

**PART-TIME TEACHER'S AIDE:** We seek a dedicated person to fill a part-time aide position for the 2022-2023 school year. The applicant must believe that the Bible is God's Word and standard for faith and daily living, and must agree with Trinity Christian School's mission and philosophy of education. The candidate will assist the teacher in prayerfully helping students learn attitudes, skills, and subject matter that will contribute to their development as mature, able and responsible Christians. This position requires morning hours, Monday through Friday.

**PRESCHOOL DIRECTOR:** Trinity Christian Preschool is looking for a qualified and vibrant director who loves working with and for children, and most importantly loves the Lord. The Preschool Director serves full-time as the educational leader, responsible for managing the policies, regulations, and procedures to ensure that all preschool students are supervised in a safe environment that meets the approved curricula and mission of the school. Inherent in the position are the responsibilities for scheduling, curriculum development, personnel management, budget planning, and facility operations. The director works collaboratively with the school administration. Minimal education would include a bachelor's degree, as well as preferred experience in the field of education.
