CALLING ALL CRAFTERS AND VENDORS!



IMPORTANT! PARKING LOT ETIQUETTE AND SAFETY

- 1. Please remember that from 8:10-8:45 a.m. and 3:10-3:30 p.m. everyone should enter the parking lot using ONLY the SOUTH entrance. Even on chapel days, please advise any visitors of this rule.


