

WHICH SWEATSHIRT TO WEAR TO SCHOOL?

As the weather gets chillier, we know kids will be wearing hoodies and sweatshirts to stay warm. Please remember school policies:

- 1. Middle school students may wear Spirit Gear hoodies at anytime of the year, and must have a uniform shirt on underneath it. Hoodies MUST be TCS Spirit Gear. No regular, everyday hoodies are allowed.


