

2021-2022 School Year

Dear Kindergarten Parents,

The first day of school is just around the corner. I am sure that your child is excited about the upcoming school year. I know that you and your child will find this an enjoyable experience.

School hours for the full-day kindergarten are 8:30 a.m.– 3:15 p.m. Students may be dropped off no earlier than 8:10 a.m. and must be picked up by 3:30 p.m. (unless enrolled in the before/after school program). Half-day kindergarten school hours are 8:30 – 11:30 a.m. Students may be dropped off no earlier than 8:10 a.m. and must be picked up at 11:30. At dismissal, the cars form a line under the canopy and your child will be brought to your car. If you send someone else to pick up your child you **MUST** inform the office.

The first few days of school you are welcome to park your car and walk your child to the classroom. We then strongly encourage you to use the drop-off line. If your child is weepy, we have found that the tears disappear as the day's activities begin.

The teacher will also explain the daily routine and answer any questions.

Please note that according to Illinois State requirements, all students entering kindergarten must provide the following documentation before they are able to start on the first day of school.

- Completed health examination
- Proper immunizations
- Dental exam
- Eye exam
